Kangaroos cannot walk backwards.

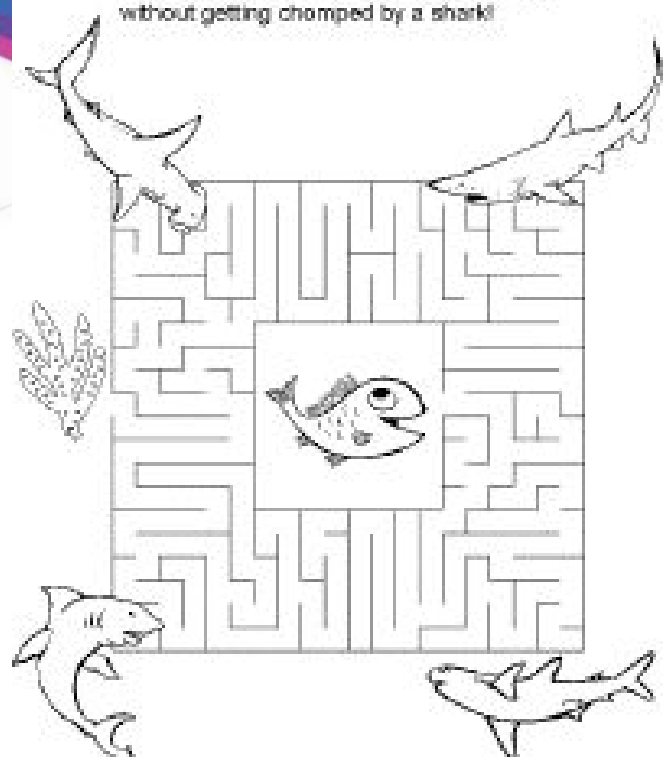
A snail's mouth is no larger than the head of a pin, but can have over 20,000 teeth! Imagine having to brush all of them!
