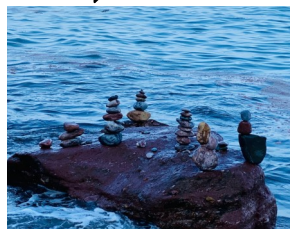

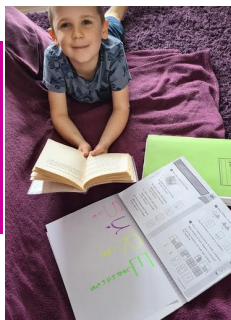

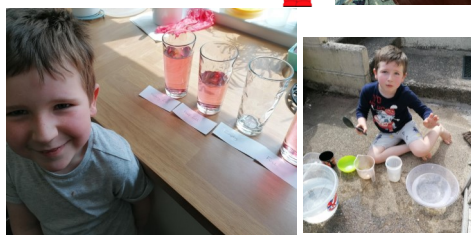
Mrs Morgan and Oakley have been enjoying the
