Key Vocabulary

- Continent-** A very large area of land that can consist of several countries.
- Country-** One of the political units in which the world is divided into, covering a particular area of land.
- Ocean-** One of the five very large areas of sea on the Earth's surface.
- Mountain-** A very high area of land with steep sides.
- Valley-** A low stretch of land between hills.
- Blizzard-** A very heavy snowstorm with strong winds.
- Iceberg-** A large, tall mass of ice floating in the sea.
- Desert-** A large area of land, usually in a hot region, where there is almost no water, rain, trees or plants.
- Sand Dune -** A hill of sand, near the sea or in a sand desert.
- Landscape -** Everything that you can see when you look across an area of land, including hills, rivers, buildings, trees and plants.
- Gorge -** A deep, narrow valley with very steep sides, usually where a river passes through mountains or an area of hard rock.
