Making a print involves transferring an image from one surface to another (usually paper). This can be repeated creating identical images over and over again.

Vocabulary

Designer: a person who draws and plans how to create something.

Print: an image made by any method involving transfer from one surface to another.

Pattern: a repeated design.

First we will explore block printing by applying paint to different objects and pressing them onto paper to create repeated patterns.

Printing using natural and man-made tools





Next we will draw a pattern and print using polystyrene.

- 1. Draw you design onto a piece of polystyrene.
- Put the roller in the paint and roll over the piece of polystyrene (covering it all with paint).
- 3. Press the polystyrene onto a piece of paper.
- 4. Repeat steps 2-3 if you want to print again.
