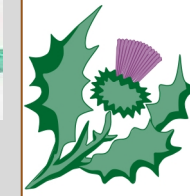


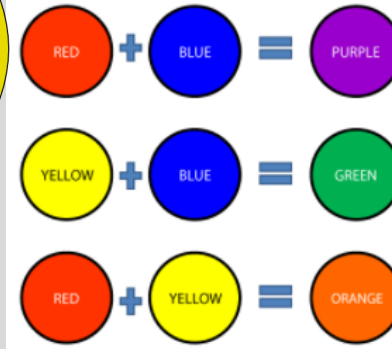
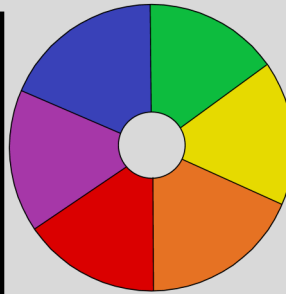
Art - Watercolour

Sir Quentin Blake, is an English cartoonist, caricaturist, illustrator and children's writer. He has **illustrated over 300 books**, including 18 written by Roald Dahl.



Watercolour is a paint that is almost **transparent**. This means paint layers can be seen through it. The more you can see through the layer of colour, the more **transparent** it is.



Much of his work is drawn with black ink and if the illustrations include colour, Quentin Blake uses watercolour over the ink. When he illustrates for books, he tries to make sure the characters look the same throughout the book.
