Our learning this week:

Ding ding! The Naughty Bus came to play this week. The children loved to see what mischief he was up to and talked with their friends about their favourite part of the story. We are so impressed with their story sentence writing, using some great finger spaces to make sure the words do not bump together. On Wednesday we had another day of learning with Mrs Posey (one of our Year One teachers) who brought some special friends with her. The children were very curious about the incubator and how it was helping the eggs. There were some great ideas about what might be growing inside. This was a lovely way to reinforce our learning about 'new life' and Mrs Posey has promised a return visit when the eggs have hatched.





When our fruit snack arrived this week we didn't have quite enough to go around. Charlie Cheetah and Ziggy Zebra helped us to problem solve this and make sure it was fair for us all. This led to lots of discussion and exploration of this concept. We worked with a partner following these steps:

- I. Choose the starting number e.g. I want to share 6.
- 2. Give each person I at a time in turn until they are all gone.
- 3. Each person to check how many.
- $\ensuremath{\textbf{\textbf{4}}}.$ Make sure each person has the same / an equal amount.

Please could you practise this at home with your child. Maybe challenge them to explore if all numbers (to 10) will share equally. We have just introduced the language 'odd' and 'even' today so your child may begin to use these words.

Butterfly News:

Perhaps it was the weather but many of them emerged into beautiful butterflies before they could come back to school and needed to be released.
