

The Qur'an

The Muslim holy book is called the

Qur'an. Muslims believe that it is a record of the exact words that Allah said.



Place of Worship

The Muslim place of worship is called a mosque. Services are held in mosques every day. The most important service for Muslims is on a Fridau.

Mosques often have a domed roof. There are no images of people or animals in mosques. They are decorated with patterns and words from the Qur'an.

Muslims take off their shoes before going into the mosque and wash before they pray. Muslims pray kneeling on the floor on a prayer mat. The wall of the mosque which faces Mccca is called the qibla wall. It has an empty arch to show the direction of Mecca.
