

Rey Vocabulary	
soluble - a substance that dissolves in water. Sugar is soluble.	thermal conductor - a material that transmits (passes on) heat. Metal is a good thermal conductor.
transparent - allows light to pass through so that objects behind them can easily be seen. Windows are transparent.	insulator - a material that does not conduct heat or electricity. Rubber is a good insulator.
translucent - allows some light to pass through. You can see through it but not clearly (semi-transparent) A lamp shade is translucent.	water resistant - a material that blocks water. It is waterproof. The bag was made of water resistant materials.
opaque - Blocks light from passing through it so you cannot see through it. The wooden door is opaque.	magnetic - attracted by a magnet. Many metals are magnetic, such as steel. Paper clips are magnetic.
electrical conductor - a material that transmits (passes on) electricity. Metal wires are electrical conductors.	flexible - capable of bending easily, without breaking. The fabric is warm and flexible.
absorbent - able to soak up liquid easily. The sponge is very <u>absor-</u> <u>bent</u> .	brittle - hard but likely to break easily under force. A snail's shell is brittle.

A material is the substance that something is made out of.


