3:30pm to 4:30pm

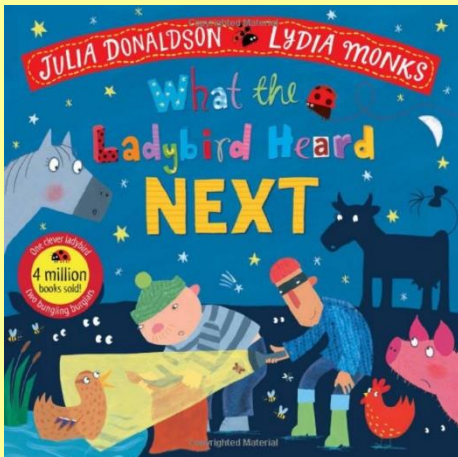


We have invited our 2023/2024 Reception children and families to join us, as well as our lovely staff from Year One who are excited to get to know you all.

Books we shared this week

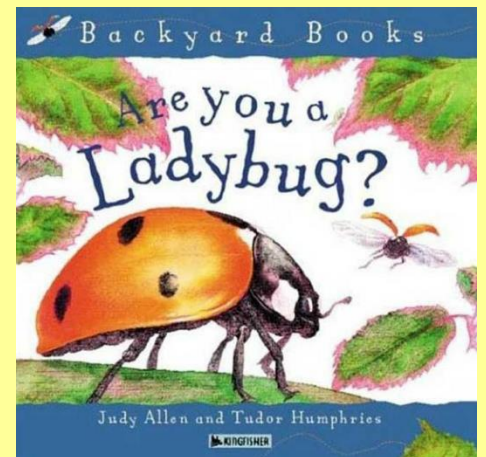
