Banana Pancakes



Ingredients

350g self raising flour

1 tsp baking powder

2 very ripe bananas

1 tsp vanilla extract

250ml milk

Butter for frying

Serve with sliced bananas
and maple syrup

Method

Sieve the flour, baking powder and a generous pinch of salt into a large bowl. In a separate mixing bowl, mash the very ripe bananas with a fork until smooth, then whisk in the eggs, vanilla extract and milk. Make a well in the centre of the dry ingredients, tip in the wet ingredients and swiftly whisk together to create smooth, silky batter.

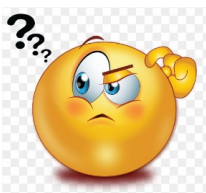
Heat a little knob of butter in a large stick pan over a medium heat. Add 2-3 tbsp of the batter to the pan and cook for several minutes, or until small bubbles start appearing on the surface. Flip the pancake over and cook for 1-2 mins on the other side. Repeat with the remaining batter, keeping the pancakes warm in a low oven.

Stack the pancakes on plates and top with the banana slices, a glug of sticky maple syrup.

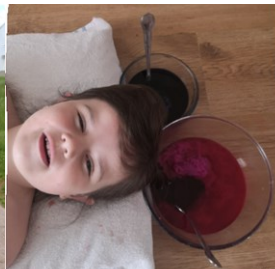

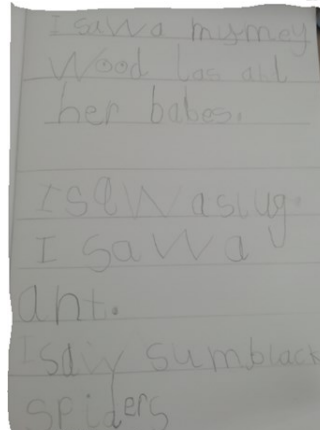

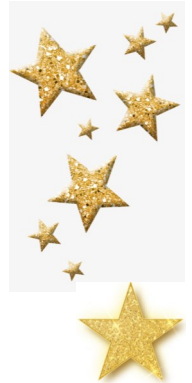

Don't forget in this hot weather to put your sun lotion on and wear a hat. Stay safe!



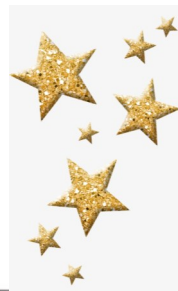
A Busy Bee!

A Fruity Treat

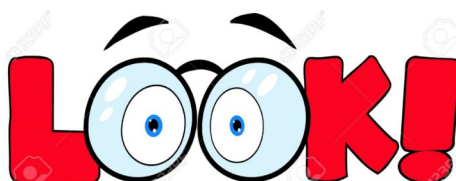
Jake is really thinking about his healthy choices this week he opted for Mango Sorbet as it is a fruity snack!
