Duties involve:

- Supervise the children during eating
- Set out/clear away and tables and chairs
- Maintaining good levels of hygiene in the hall at all times
- Sweeping the hall to ensure it is left in a clean and presentable condition at the end of mealtime
- Building good relationships with children in the dining hall
- Encourage children to eat
- Deal with minor injuries and behaviour
- Cleaning up spillages of liquids, food and sickness
- Making sure the children are safe
- Attending training sessions as necessary
- Being punctual and reliable

The pay is £12.45 per hour (pay award pending). We required someone for 1.75 hours daily (11.45am to 1.30pm), 5 days a week. Term time only (38 weeks).
