



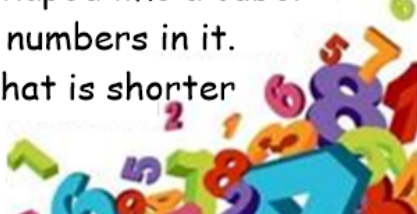

- Something that is shorter than you.



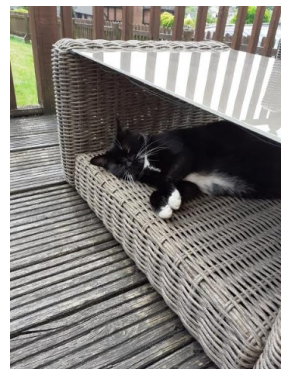
Joke of the week!

Can you work out where I went for a walk?



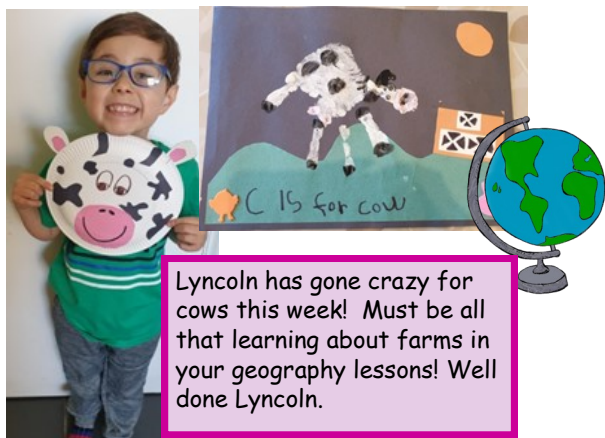

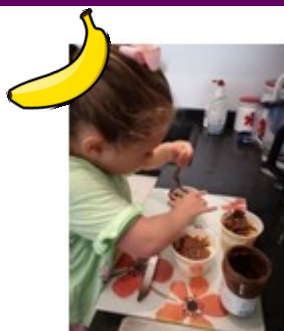

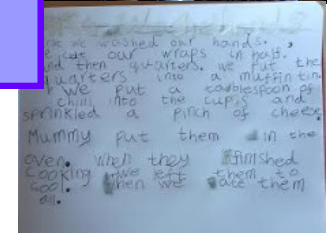
Lincoln has gone crazy for cows this week! Must be all that learning about farms in your geography lessons! Well done Lincoln.



Mrs Tandy is very impressed with Kaja's Banana Project! She designed a banana surprise.



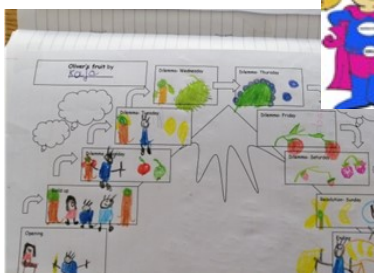
Veronica has made some yummy chilli cups. She even wrote the instructions for her friends to make them too!



Mrs Turner was impressed with Oliver's enthusiasm and ideas for his instructions. Well done Oliver, keep up the fab effort!

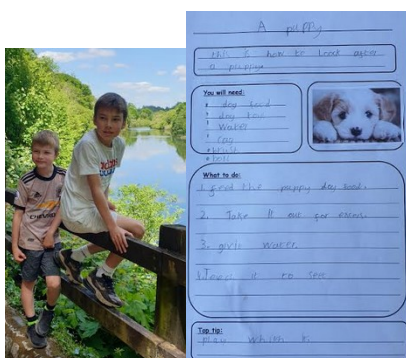


Check out Miley's cake stand. Showing kindness to others as always. Well done Miley!
