

Foundation Stage News

Our learning for next week:

The children have been full of great ideas and knowledge about what is under their feet. We have started to learn about the different ways in which people and animals use the underground.

Next week we will meet a fictional character called 'Archie the Archaeologist' and we will learn about how people look underground to find out about what life was like in the past. We will be creating a dig site containing artefacts from long ago. When looking at these objects we will encourage the children to be 'Think-a-docuses' and say what they think it could be. We will encourage them to explain their ideas using a full sentence starting with "I think it could be a...."

In our maths learning we have been exploring the concept of 'whole'. A whole can be represented by one object, if some of the whole object is missing it is not the whole (e.g. an apple with a bite taken out is no longer a whole). Next week we will learn about the concept of 'parts' and will teach the children that a whole can be spit into two or more parts in many different ways. We will learn three key facts:

- I) The parts might look different (in shape/size/quantity)
- 2) Each part will be smaller than the whole
- 3) The parts can be combined to make the whole

We will be exploring parts and wholes in many different ways e.g. cutting a whole banana, filling containers in the water tray, cutting up a whole picture into parts.

You can help at home by reinforcing this language of 'whole' and 'part' in daily life e.g. look you ate up your whole dinner, you have finished part of your jigsaw.
