Dear Parents and Guardians,

Happy New Year and welcome back! We hope you had a restful and enjoyable Christmas break. As we start a new term, we would like to remind you of some key information.

In class, we will continue to use plenty of play based learning. These play based opportunities will be interspersed with short whole-class, teacher led carpet sessions and small group work. Reading

Please continue to support your child by reading with them as much as possible at home. Four 'reads' per week at home make a big difference to a child's reading progress. Please record these reads with the date and a brief description in their Reading Record. These will be checked each Monday.

Certificates are awarded in Friday's assembly:

40 Reads—Bronze certificate	80 Reads—Silver certificate,
120 reads—Gold certificate	160 reads—Star certificate,
200 reads—Head teacher award,	240 reads—Governor award.

Maths - Numbots

Please continue to support your child to access Numbots at home if possible. Numbots is a personalised maths programme that supports each child at their own level.

PE Days

Pine and Beech Class: **Wednesday and Thursday**

Mr Mayling, our specialist PE teacher, will be teaching two PE lessons per week. Please send your child into school wearing their PE kit on these days (please see website for our current PE uniform). Earrings must be removed or taped up with plasters before coming to school. We will have 1 lesson outside each week so please ensure they have a jumper or tracksuit bottoms to wear on cold days.
