

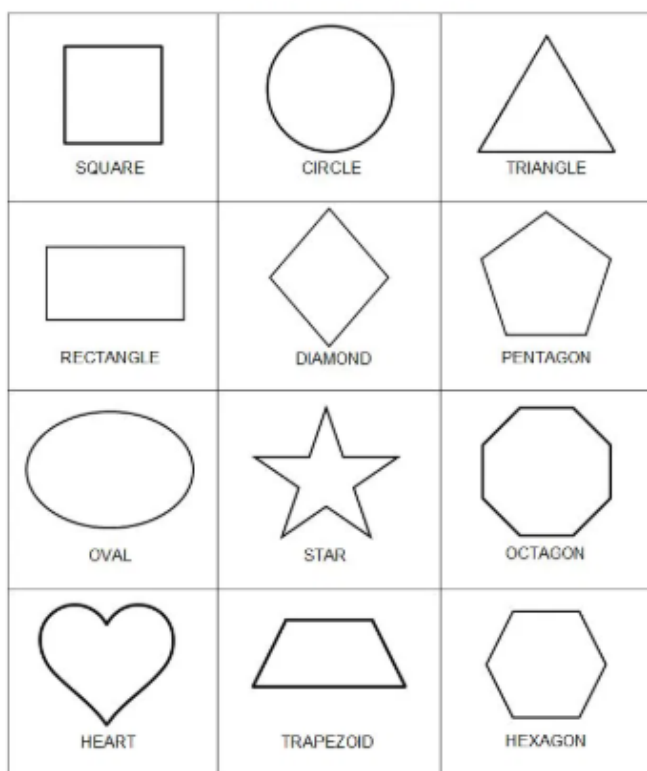

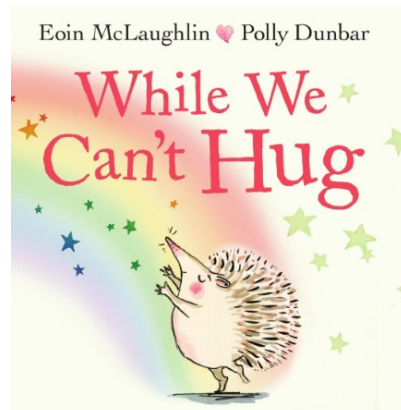
Year 1 have been making kites this week. What is the best shaped kite for flying? Maybe you could make one.

Amazing effort from Isaac. He has been learning to ride his bike and after 10 minutes this was how well he was doing!



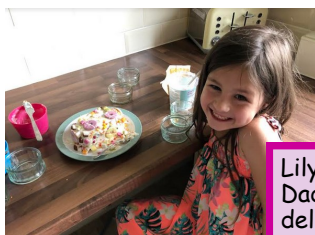
If the sun hides from the wind then we can fly our kite like Year 1!

Lily has been busy making her Dad a birthday cake. It looks delicious! I am sure he loved it.

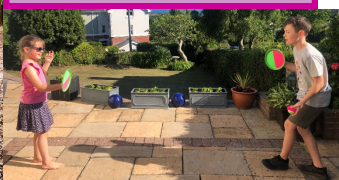
Maisie and Seren have been scientists this week. I thought Mrs Tandy had green fingers but that definitely
