Easy Biscuits

Ingredients:

100g butter

50g sugar

150g self raising flour

Method:

1 Ask an adult to turn the oven on to 180c

2 In a bowl soften the butter until it is light and fluffy.

3 Then mix in the sugar.

4 Put in the flour and with your hand mix and knead it all together to make a dough.

5 Remove a small amount and roll it in your hands to make a ball, then put it on a baking tray (top tip: use greaseproof paper because it stops it from sticking to the tray).

6 Repeat 5 until all of the mixture has been used.

7 Use a fork to push the balls of mixture a little flat before putting them in the oven.

8 Finally bake them for about 12 minutes until they are golden.



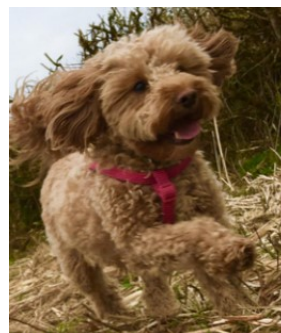
Mrs Turner has made these a few times and her family keep eating them— she can't make them quick enough!

This is Barney he is like my shadow.

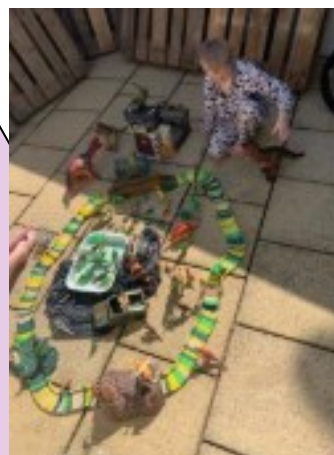

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Frankie has been working on his dance moves with Monty Mole—great dancing Frankie!

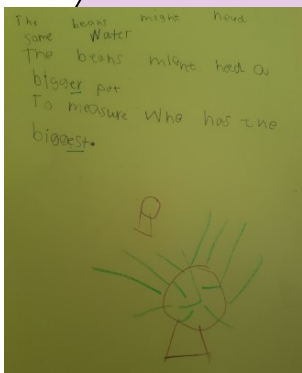


Edith has worked really hard with her home learning.
