## Contraction and apostrophes

### Spelling Zone

Sometimes we squash two words together to make one word.

**I am** going on holiday!

**I'm** going on holiday!

**I** and **am** have been squashed together and **a** has been squeezed out. An **apostrophe** has taken its place.

Sometimes 2 letters are squeezed out, like this:

**I will** see you later.

**I'll** see you later.

**I** and **will** have been squashed together and **w** and **i** have been squeezed out. An **apostrophe** has taken their place.

We call these **contractions**.

You are = you're

he is = he's

she will = she'll

we are = we're
