Time for our weekly news and updates.

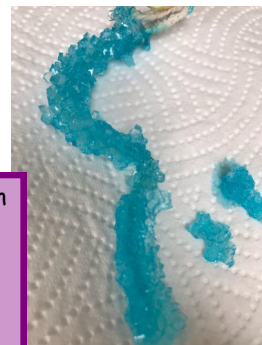


Poppy has been a super busy bee! You are a star home learner!
