## Our learning this week:

Our week started with a wiggly surprise. A mystery box arrived with some clues on the front to help us guess what could be inside:







We carefully transferred the baby caterpillars into their sticky food pots and have put them somewhere safe whilst they grow.

Our information book told us how caterpillars change into butterflies. We discovered that this is called a life-cycle. We made our own life-cycle wheels to help us to remember the changes that happen. Maybe your child can use their Life-cycle at home to tell you what happens at each stage.



We have observed the caterpillars carefully this week, remembering how to show our value of kindness and respect....shhhh! We noticed how they move by crawling and explored this in the Art Studio making our own wiggly caterpillars. We learned that we can use string, a pipe cleaner or a split pin to make a moving mechanism.
